2021 ASIAN AMERICAN AND PACIFIC ISLANDER HERITAGE MONTH

Whereas, Ferguson Township celebrates the cultural and ethnic diversity that makes up the rich fabric of our community; and

Wirecas, the Ferguson Township Board of Supervisors stands in solidarity with the Asian American and Pacific Islander (AAPI) community in the Township and around the world against the systemic racism, xenophobia, and misogyny that has afflicted our fellow citizens for centuries in this country and around the world; and

Whereas, according to United States Census Bureau estimates, the AAPI population in Ferguson Township exceeds fifteen percent of our citizenry; and

Wijereas, Ferguson Township, by adopting this proclamation, commits to making our community a welcoming and inviting place for AAPI residents, business owners, visitors, and students.

Protot, therefore, the Ferguson Township Board of Supervisors does hereby designate May 2021 as Asian American and Pacific Islander Heritage Month and encourages all residents of Ferguson Township to celebrate the immeasurable value that our friends, families, and neighbors of AAPI heritage add to our quality of life.
