PROCLAMATION

NUMBER 15 OF 2021

WHEREAS, those of Asian and Pacific Islander origin contribute to and enrich our community with their creativity, enterprise and skill as professors, scientists, technologists, doctors, students, entrepreneurs, artists, workers, writers, investors, elected officials, philanthropists and more, building and supporting a vibrant and resilient economy in Centre County, and

WHEREAS those of Asian and Pacific Islander origin are our beloved friends and family, our cherished neighbors, and valued members of Centre County, where we remain committed to embracing and accepting all our residents from diverse backgrounds,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Centre County Board of Commissioners does hereby proclaim May 2021 as "Asian Pacific American Heritage Month" in Centre County, and encourage all Centre County residents to celebrate the history and culture of Asian Pacific Islanders and Asian Pacific Americans and their vital contributions to our county, our commonwealth and our country.
